

This week Radio Nova looked at the emergence of Refill Shops around the country.

Did you know...

- Ireland generated 1.12 million tonnes of packaging waste in 2020.
- Producing plastic products from recycled plastics reduces energy requirements by 66%.
- Recycling just 1 tonne of plastics saves 1,000–2,000 gallons of petroleum.
- It takes up to **500 years** for plastic to decompose.

Why use a Refill Shop?

- Most grocery products can be refilled in one of these shops
- Using a refill shop cuts out the cost to the customer of the usual unnecessary packaging
- By using a refill shop you are also supporting various local producers

How does it work?

- 1. Simply bring in your own containers. We weigh
- 2. The container is then weighed before it's filled, and then reweighed.
- 3. You pay for the products, not the packaging!
